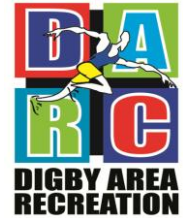


Title: Swim Instructor
Reports To: Aquatic Coordinator
Nature: Seasonal (8 weeks, 30 hours/week)



Description:

The Swim Instructor is responsible for teaching and evaluating candidates participating in the Royal Lifesaving Swim For Life and Canadian Swim Patrol programs.

Responsibilities (but not limited to):

- Be familiar with Royal Lifesaving Swim For Life program and know how to use course materials effectively
- Providing swim lessons in a group lesson or private lesson ;teaching swimming techniques, swimming strokes, and water safety rules to students with varying swimming abilities. To maintain accurate records of student's progress.
- Assisting more experienced swimmers to enhance their swimming abilities.
- Assessing the progress of students and adjusting teaching programs accordingly.
- Monitoring students to prevent accidents and injuries.
- Planning swimming lessons that take into account students' abilities and progressive development.
- Identifying incorrect swimming techniques and correcting students accordingly.
- Communicate regularly with participants and their parents, as appropriate, to ensure they are aware of progress.
- Provide for the health and safety of participants, including ensuring that all teaching and practice areas are free of hazards, and that materials and equipment are safe.
- Respond to accidents, provide First Aid, and write incident safety reports.
- Check that the pool is chemically balanced in order to meet the minimum opening standards and to complete ongoing pool tests.
- Other duties as assigned by a supervisor.

Requirements:

- Current Lifesaving Swim For Life Swim Instructor Certification, or equivalent
- Current CPR & First Aid Certification
- Previous teaching/lifeguarding experience is an asset
- Effective decision making, communication, time management and supervisory skills.
